Sports 2000 Duratec

Age: 34 **Lives:** Wolverhampton **Wins:** six

Championship position: first

With his re-fettled Gunn TS6, a determined Jenvey (see left, car ten) got the better of a thrilling fight with Sports 2000 Duratec master Rick Johnson. The fight between the pair started at Silverstone (where they collided) and went on for the whole season. Jenvey kept the pressure on and won the title in fine style, pulling a brave pass on his rival into Paddock Hill Bend at Brands Hatch in October.

Wins: seven

Championship position: 1st

Rising teenage star reinforced his 2008 potential with a crushing season-long performance. He was only twice off the podium in 14 Caterham races.
